

## **1. Health Care Policy for Registered Students.**

This health care policy would be applicable to the registered students as discussed below:

- (a) All the registered students at IIT Indore are entitled to OPD medical facility, basic investigations and treatment available in the IIT Health Centre. The student will pay the medical fee during registration every six months.
- (b) The student may be referred for consultation with a medical specialist or for an investigation to an empanelled hospital by the treating doctor. Please refer to the "Note" below.
- (c) The health centre has IPD facility only for minor ailments. Further, IPD facilities would be provided only through group medical Insurance Policy available for students.
- (d) IPD treatment not covered by the medical Insurance Policy available for students, will be borne by the student or his/her parents/ guardian. Any difference of the amount claimed by the Hospital and the final amount passed by the Insurance Agency will be borne by the student.
- (e) Dental care - Student can avail basic dental treatment at IIT health centre. Root canal, filling, and any advanced dental treatment shall be covered as per the group medical insurance policy for students and/or by guardian.
- f) Diseases requiring prolonged medicines will be covered maximum up to 3 months subject to availability at IIT Health Centre. For more details, please refer the "Note" below.
- g) No reimbursement for any expenditure on medical consultation, treatment and investigation would be provided by the Institute.

### **"Note"-**

- Chronic diseases, pre-existing illnesses, specialized medical care and cosmetic treatments will not be covered by the Institute.
- Students should be required to get themselves vaccinated before arrival at the campus as advised by IIT Health Centre. Pre-joining physical fitness will be submitted by them.

### **For IPD treatment:**

- Students are required to carry their medical insurance card and identity card while visiting empanelled hospitals.

- In case of availing IPD facility, the student must inform the Corporate Desk and emergency number on the insurance card regarding their admission.

## **2. Medical facility for Dependents of married registered research scholars (students) for basic and emergency medical facility.**

A list of dependents of registered students will be shared with IITI Health Centre team every semester by the Office of Student Affairs. Dependents will include spouse and children only. For spouse and dependent children, an additional amount of ₹1500 for every 06 months will be charged. They will be eligible for OPD consultation at IITI Health Centre only and medicines up to a maximum of 5 days, subject to availability in IITI Health Centre. No reimbursement will be provided to them.

## **3. Medical facility for registered International Students.**

The list of registered international students will be shared with IITI Health Centre team every semester by the Office of Academic Affairs/ International Affairs. Following are the health care rules for registered international students:

- (a) Pre-joining physical fitness, certified by a registered medical practitioner, is to be submitted to IITI Health Centre prior to arrival on campus.
- (b) All registered international students at IIT Indore are entitled to OPD medical facility, basic investigation and treatment available in IITI Indore Health Centre. The international students will pay the medical fee during registration every six months.
- (c) The student may be referred for consultation with a medical specialist or investigation to an empanelled hospital by the treating doctor. Please refer the “Note” below for more information.
- (d) IPD facilities would be provided only through Mediclaim Insurance Policy available for students.
- (e) All registered international students would be covered through Mediclaim Insurance Policy available for students on payment of the premium. However, the territorial jurisdiction of the provisions of medical facilities would be as per the norms of the Mediclaim Insurance Policy.
- (f) IPD treatment not covered by the Mediclaim Insurance Policy available for students, will be borne by the student or his/her parents/ guardian. Any

difference of the amount claimed by the Hospital and final amount approved by the insurance agency will be borne by the student.

- (g) Dental care- Student can avail basic dental treatment at health centre. Root canal, filling and any advanced dental treatment shall be covered as per Group medical insurance policy for students and/or by student/guardian.
- (h) Diseases requiring prolonged medicines will be covered maximum up to 3 months subject to availability in the Health Centre. Please refer the “Note” below.
- (i) No reimbursement for any expenditure on medical consultation, treatment and investigation would be provided by the Institute.

**“Note”-**

- Chronic diseases, pre-existing illnesses, specialized medical care and cosmetic treatments will not be covered by the institute.
- Students should get themselves vaccinated before arrival on the campus as advised by IITI Health Centre.

**For IPD treatment:**

- Students are required to carry their medical insurance card and identity card while visiting empanelled hospitals.
- In case of availing IPD facility, the student must inform the corporate desk and emergency number on the insurance card regarding their admission.

**4. Medical facility for International Students engaged with the Institute for a duration less than 01 year:**

The list of these international students will be shared with IITI Health Centre team every month by the Office of Academic Affairs/International Affairs and ID card will be issued by the concerned section. Following are the health care rules for such international students:

- a) Before arrival to the campus, the must be covered under appropriate health insurance applicable in India.
- b) Pre-joining physical fitness, certified by a registered medical practitioner has to be submitted to the IITI Health Centre prior to arrival on campus.

- c) An amount of ₹1500 for every 06 months will be charged to these students as for basic Health Care facility at health centre. This charge would be applicable for any duration less than 6 months. These charges are subject to revision from time to time.
- d) These international students can avail OPD medical facility, basic investigation and treatment available in IITI Health Centre. Please refer the “Note” below.
- e) IPD facilities would be provided only through the Health Insurance purchased by these students. No reimbursement for any expenditure on medical consultation, treatment and investigation would be provided by the Institute.

**“Note”-**

- Chronic diseases, pre-existing illnesses, specialized medical care and cosmetic treatments will not be covered by the institute.
- Students should be required to get themselves vaccinated before arrival at the campus as advised by IITI Health Centre.
